1. Sign-in to your account
2. Click Events (on the left or on the drop down menu)
3. Locate the event you are looking for:  
"Kewaunee County Archery 101"
4. Click on the event and proceed through the registration process.  
You will receive a confirmation email.

## It's 4-H Re-enrollment Time!

It's that time of year—4-H re-enrollment time for members and volunteers.

### Where do I go to re-enroll?

Go to <http://wi.4honline.com> to access the new system. Your family login will be the same as you used last year.

**Are there step-by-step instructions to follow?** You bet: <https://fyi.extension.wisc.edu/4h-ext/files/2020/09/4HOnline.v2.Family.Enrollment.Guide.pdf> for help during the enrollment process.

Whether you are a new or returning family, read through the attached guide will help you through enrolling in Wisconsin 4-H. Please read this page for a summary of the steps needed to enroll.

- If you are a **new family**, start with Creating a New 4-H Online Account on page 3. After you create your login account, you will be prompted to Add a New Member to the Family right away. To add additional family members, click on the Add Member button on your family member list screen.
- If you are a **returning family**, start with Logging in to an Existing 4-H Online Account on page 2. To re-enroll any existing adult or youth member, click on the Enroll Now link for the member on your family member list screen. Instructions for re-enrolling a youth start on page 7 and instructions for adults on page 11.

**Literature order:** The 4-H Leaders Association pays for each member to have literature to go along with your projects. If you would like to know more about the projects and what is available for literature, please see the **Project List** booklet at: <https://fyi.extension.wisc.edu/kewaunee4h/4-h-enrollment/> and order at the form link below.

- If there are pieces of literature that you would like to order to go along with your projects, please fill out this form by the re-enrollment deadline: <https://forms.gle/2o73LZrDsERisYQr9>
- We will let you know when your literature order is in and complete (this sometimes take a while because it is coming from multiple sources) and how to pick it up.

### What should I do if my password doesn't work or I forgot it?

If your password does not work, click on the Reset Password link on the login page and you will be emailed a new one.

All current families, we ask that you re-enroll no later than October 31, 2021

Yes, you can add or delete projects until February 1, 2022 in your 4-H online account.

## Cedar Crest 4-H Ice Cream Creation Contest

Cedar Crest Ice Cream, Cedarburg, Wisconsin, and the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation have teamed up again to present the "Cedar Crest Ice Cream 4-H Flavor Contest" for Wisconsin 4-H clubs. More than 1600 clubs are eligible to create and submit a flavor 'recipe' with the top clubs named as finalists, and the top flavor produced for summer 2021.

Last year, Kewaunee County's own Champion Sparkplugs were finalists in the ice cream creation contest with their flavor idea, Bunny Fluff - Blue moon and vanilla ice cream swirled together with mini marshmallows, marshmallow fluff and white chocolate chips. As finalists, they received an ice cream party for their club. Maybe your club's idea could be the big winner for this year. This could be a great club meeting – come up with the ice cream flavor submission together.

According to Brenda Scheider, Executive Director of the Wisconsin 4-H Foundation, the contest is a great opportunity for 4-H youth to work together to develop and name their flavor. "The most exciting part of the contest is the winning flavor will be available through Cedar Crest beginning next July."

A panel of ice cream experts chosen by Cedar Crest judges the entries. The company manufactures more than 80 flavors of ice cream, along with frozen custard, sherbet and sorbet at its Manitowoc, Wisconsin, plant, and distributes products in five states. Many of the flavors now produced by Cedar Crest, including Wisconsin Campfire S'mores and Big Muddy, are a result of the contest.
