Soil Testing Available at Extension

Looking to find out what's in your garden soil? Bring in a sample for testing.

1. Select the sample location.
2. Take your soil sample—about 1-2 cups from different areas.
3. Package your soil sample in a plastic bag or use a sample bag from Extension.
4. Bring your soil sample in to Extension Kewaunee County and we will help you fill out a submission form and mail your sample to the lab.
