## **Excellence in Nonprofit Leadership Certificate**

In this course instructor Shane Kohl will teach about the components of a strong development program, team, and culture of philanthropy in your organization. You will learn about making a compelling case for support, designing purposeful events, engaging corporate donors, stimulating online giving, and stewarding your supporters. On February 21, you can learn from UW-Madison Extension's Patrick Nehring and Melinda Pollen about Developing an Active Board of Directors. The other courses are Foundations of Financial Management, Human Resource Management, and Marketing & Communication Strategy. Upon completing the capstone project you can receive an exclusive UW-Green Bay credential, a digital badge validating your accomplishment. The courses are \$169 and the capstone project is \$99.
